## **TURNAGAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2016-07**

## **RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SYDNEY'S SHORTCUT**

WHEREAS, the Turnagain Community Council (TCC) is an all-volunteer, self-governing neighborhood organization recognized in the Municipality of Anchorage charter; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of community councils is to provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation in government and local affairs; and

WHEREAS, local community members have contacted TCC regarding the development of property at 2803 Marston Drive where the landowners have blocked access and landscaped over a frequently used trail called Sydney's Shortcut; and

WHEREAS, Sydney's Shortcut was deeded in 1955 to the Turnagain Heights Subdivision by the subdivision developers, the Marston and Morris families, as a 20' platted right of way created to "...give access to and from the beach"; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has deemed the easement to be valid; and

WHEREAS, the easement is shown on the as-built survey submitted by the landowners to the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the landowners were notified of the recorded easement when they acquired the property in 2013; and

WHEREAS, more than 100 neighbors have signed the petition demanding protection of public access from Marston Drive to the Tony Knowles Coastal Trail; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that TCC supports the return of Sydney's Shortcut to the Turnagain neighborhood as was intended by the easement; and

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that TCC recommends to the Municipality of Anchorage that action be taken to persuade or compel the landowners to honor the easement.
