Solarize Rabbit Creek is an opportunity for Rabbit Creek residents to participate in the Solarize Anchorage program by forming a neighborhood group to collectively contract and install solar power in their homes.

Benefits:

- 1. Federal tax credit (26% in 2020)
- 2. RCA net metering benefit (i.e. the 'grid' acts as a battery to absorb your excess solar energy production and credit your account for future usage)
- 3. Contractor discount (negotiated in the RFP process), approximately 10%
- 4. Shorter time frame (on average) than doing it on your own
- 5. Build community connect with your neighbors!

Process and estimated timeline:

- 1. Find a minimum number of people (goal is 50) interested in learning more about the program PLEASE SPREAD THE WORD!
- 2. Small group leads the RFP process (with the local solar installers) Fall 2019
- 3. Confirm installer and begin individual home estimates Spring 2020
- 4. Install by the end of 2020 (estimated)

Neighborhoods already in the program:

- 1. Airport Heights (33 homes completed)
- 2. Rogers Park (36 homes completed)
- 3. Spenard (5 homes completed)
- 4. Turnagain (74 homes completed)
- 5. South Addition (48 homes completed)
