and generates

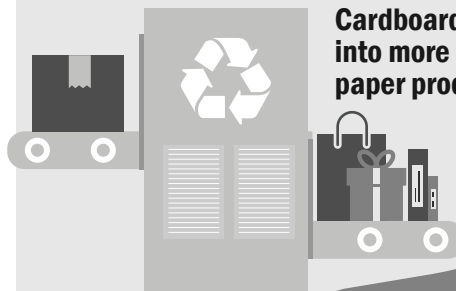
90% less EMISSIONS than a can produced from new material.



Don't toss your cardboard in the trash!

RECYCLE it instead

Cardboard can be remade into more packaging and paper products.



Cardboard can also be used to create compost in gardens - worms love them!



Nearly 50% of all aluminum cans produced are recycled.

Let's get to 100%!

Our landfill has less than ~40 years before it reaches full capacity.

More than half of our waste could be diverted to compost or recycling.

CTS made it simple to recycle, repurpose, and reuse items, so they don't get tossed in the trash.

REUSING is a great way to reduce the amount of trash filling our landfill.

BONUS: ONE PERSON'S TRASH

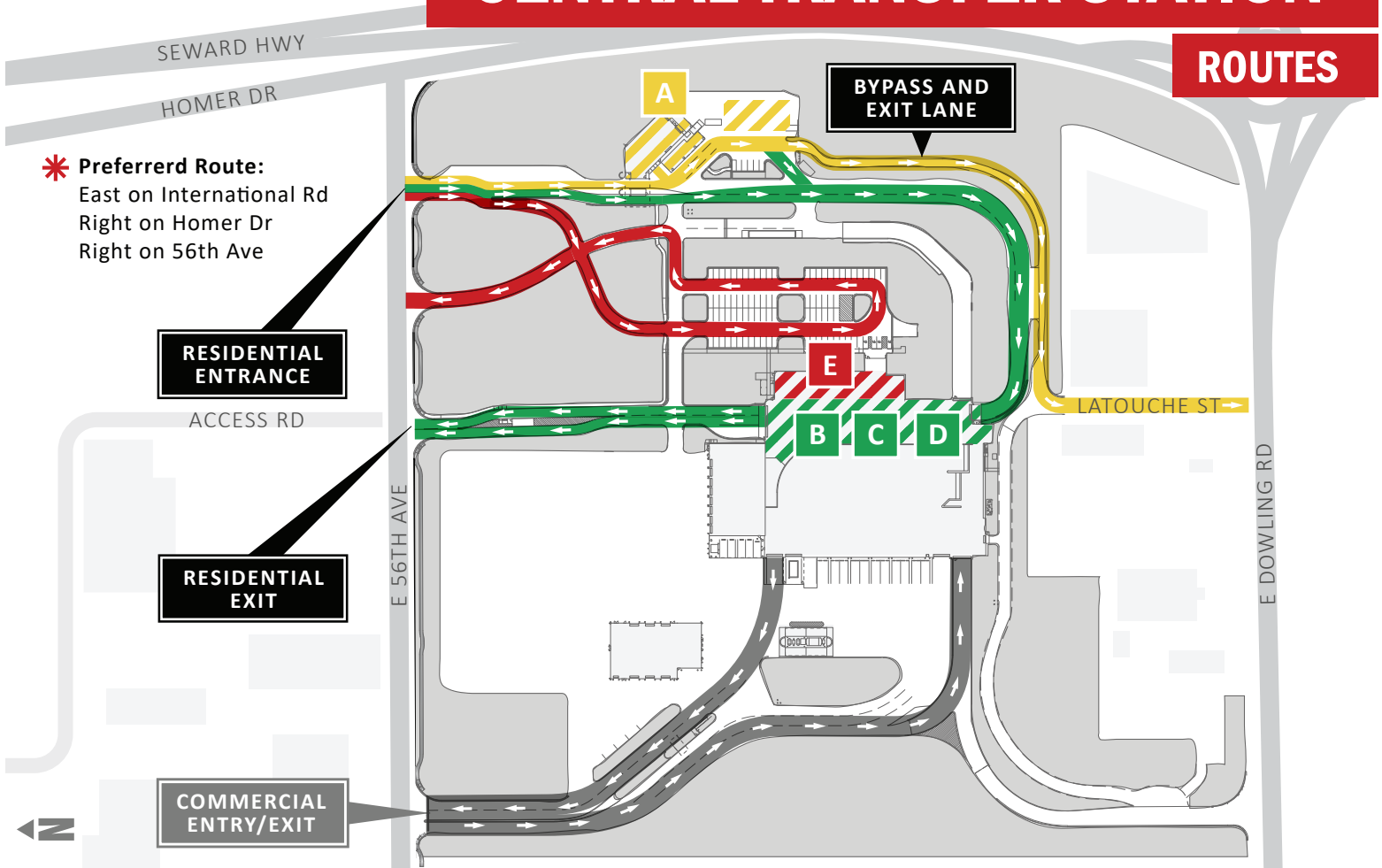
The new Central Transfer Station has more space to expand the reuse opportunities in Anchorage.

Key Facilities for Residents Visiting CTS

- A** Household Hazardous Waste (HHW), Reuse, Metal Appliances Recycling, Repurposing
- B** Garbage
- C** Recycling
- D** Composting
- E** Customer Service and Observation Deck

Services provided at the Central Transfer Station

- Reuse**
 - By HHW, leave something and take something. Free 40 lbs per person, per day, per Anchorage verified residential address.
- Metal Appliances**
 - Stoves, water heaters, washers, scrap metal are recycled.
- Repurpose** (operated by reMade)
 - Collects household furniture and other items that may be broken and is repurposed into new items.
- Recycling**
 - At the public wall, comingled recyclables such as cardboard, mixer paper, steel cans (rinsed), aluminum cans, plastic #1 and #2 bottles accepted.
- Composting**
 - Through October, kitchen scraps only, no landscaping items at this time. This gets collected and sent to a farm in the Mat-Su Valley.

Tips Before You Arrive

- **All loads must be covered** - for the safety on the road, cover your load. If load is not covered, a fine will be assessed.
- HHW daily limit is 40 lbs free, per day per residential address. Be prepared to show verification of address.
- All refrigerator doors must be removed and completely emptied prior to arriving at the booth.
- Cellphone use on campus is prohibited.
- Please yield to large red transfer trucks.
- Drive slowly, 10 MPH.
