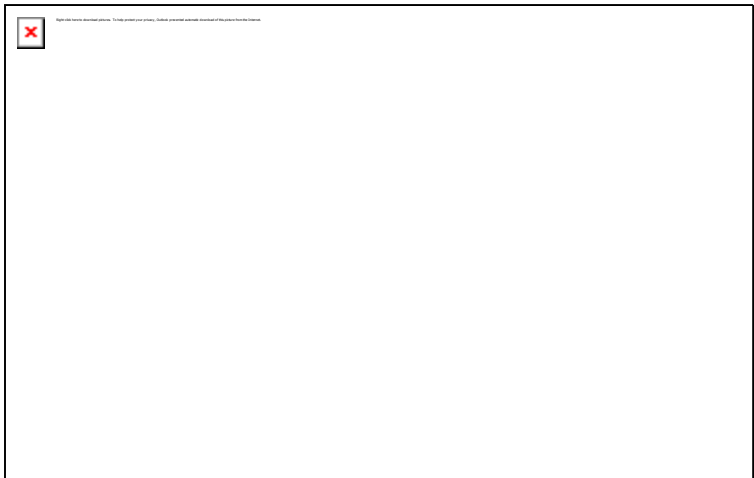

<h2>New Snow Removal Report Launched</h2> <p>It just keeps snowing in Anchorage and there is more in the forecast. To keep you informed on how we are dealing with all this snow, we have launched an online Snow Removal Report. It is updated every afternoon, with information on what streets were plowed overnight, and what is being worked on that day. Read more about what information is in the report here.</p> <p>Please continue to be patient, crews are working 24/7 and are doing a great job. We have had 119.6 inches of snow so far this winter; normally at this point we have 50 inches. MOA has spent over \$3 million more than last winter on snow removal.</p> <p>We are only 13.2 inches away from hitting the record for the all time snowiest winter on record. 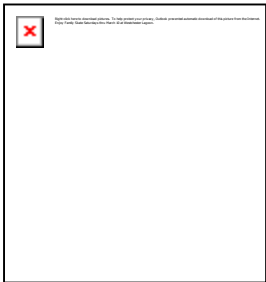
