The capital budget recently passed by the Legislature includes a number of neighborhood construction, maintenance, and education priorities. Over the next few weeks, the Governor will decide which projects in the capital budget will be vetoed and which will be funded. We wanted to draw your attention to some of the items we worked hard for and were successful in securing in the budget that affect the Fairview area:

- 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue Bike Boulevard – P Street to Medfra - \$100,000
- Fairview Elementary School – School Site Improvements – \$175,000
- Competitive Grants for Chronic Inebriate and Anti-Recidivism Treatment Programs \$4,000,000

We would like to encourage you and members of the community who support these grants to write to the Governor and Karen Rehfeld, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, to let them know how important these projects are to the community.
